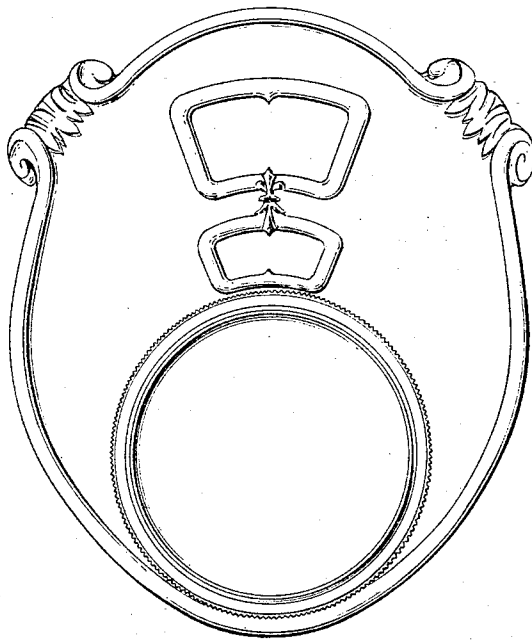
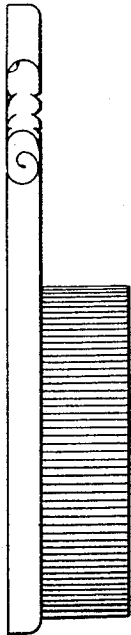

DESIGN FOR A RADIO DIAL PLATE.

Application filed May 26, 1927. Serial No. 22,168. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARTHUR DORSEY, a citizen of the United States, residing in the borough of Manhattan, of the city of New York, in the State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental design for Radio Dial Plate, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Figure 1 of the drawings is a view in front elevation of the radio dial plate.

Figure 2 is a view in side elevation of the plate shown in Figure 1.
